Winter sunset skies can be dramatic or soothing. Students will create small studies of various cloud formations, employing traditional watercolor techniques that will be reviewed in class. After choosing the color combination of choice, students will create an 8" x 10 painting of a simple Chesapeake scene. Day two will expound on these skills and artists will create a 2nd painting of choice.

Materials list: **Good quality paper**, this makes a BIG difference, 140 lb watercolor paper (Arches is preferable) 9x 12 pad or 1, 22x 30 sheet. KIFA also has watercolor paper at \$5.00/sheet Tube watercolors: Cobalt Blue, Permanent Rose or Rose Madder, and Aureolin yellow. Bonus colors if you want: Ultramarine Blue, Winsor Orange and Opera Rose. Large & medium soft bristle watercolor brushes. Pencil and eraser, palette or ceramic plate. Some art supplies are available at My Little Studio in Stevensville. KIFA members get 10% off art supplies at My Little Studio.
