

Supervisor Hebert called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. at the Ganges Township Hall located at the corner of 119th Ave. and 64th St. Board members present by roll call attendance: Looman, Yonkers, Hebert, Reimink, and Hutchins.

Public Comments:

Bob Simonds, 2318 Lakeshore Dr, reported the Pier Cove Beach parking issues were well handled by the hired reserve officers from the Allegan County Sheriff's Department and supplied pictures.

Harvey Busscher, 2126 Lakeshore Dr, reported he continues to receive water across his property from both the east and west sides of Lakeshore Dr and is concerned about the recent e-coli contamination reported at County Park. He feels the septic facility at the park is not functioning properly.

Cari Bausone, 6964 Lakeshore Ct, reiterated her concerns with the flooding problems in Wind & Woods.

Supervisor Hebert opened the Public Hearing for the Proposed Millage Rates and Budgets for the 2010/2011 Fiscal Year at 7:10 PM. Hebert explained the rates to be levied, and asked for questions and comments though none were received.

Hebert then reviewed the proposed 2010/2011 General Fund, Fire Fund, Road Fund, Ambulance Fund, First Responder Fund, and Building Administration Fund budgets, with no public comments or questions received.

Sally Howard, Planning Commission Chair, reported the Commission has scheduled June 29 & 30 for the Zoning Ordinance public hearings. Both hearings will be held at the Glenn Community Center. A decision on the Martinson project was postponed due to additional information being required.
