

Clerk's report to Councillors for 4/11/19 (matters arising from the minutes)

**Matters arising from 9<sup>th</sup> September minutes:**

**190909/5 + 8** A Highways meeting had been arranged and various matters discussed. Glos. CC had agreed to several repairs/investigations. This will be reviewed in more detail at the meeting.

**190909/7** All planning responses had been submitted.

**Matters arising from 7<sup>th</sup> October minutes:**

**All planning responses were submitted on time.** I attended the Planning committee meeting to represent the Council regarding the application for the PETT Archive Centre. A resident also spoke to Members.

**191007/09** Mobile speed enforcement van (Response from Sgt. El Lakin):

"We generally request this through having in place a speed monitoring strip, which will give us an indication of speeding through the area. Plus if we have had a high number of RTC's in the location.

If a certain percentage of cars are found to speed through the area- if there is a suitable location- we can request the area be identified for the Road Safety partnership camera enforcement van.

We are also encouraging the local community to set up their own Community Speedwatch schemes- where we will provide some training for local residents and a kit can be purchased or loaned to be used for this purpose.

I have copied in your local officer PCSO Chapman who will liaise with you around this."
