

The wonderful 2016 school year has come to an end. We are thankful for God's faithfulness and hand of mercy upon Trinity Hill. The 2015-16 school year brought many blessings. We tried an online auction for the first time that contributed to our PTF (Parent Teacher Fellowship) account with money going toward our outdoor playground structure and equipment. This is also the first year TCS was involved in a Serve-a-thon. It was awesome to see each child exercise putting their faith into action within the community and donate to our missionaries in Kenya as well. This event also contributed to the PTF fund going towards the outdoor playground improvements. Together these events helped to meet our goal of \$24,000. Our playground will host a new play structure and new equipment by the time school starts in September, and Sunday School children will be the first to enjoy it. Thank you to all who participated in making Trinity Christian School improvements; all of which are noticed and greatly appreciated! A video of the Serve-a-thon will be coming to the website soon. There were additional surveillance cameras mounted, twenty-two new computers were added to the technology lab and tuition assistance was made available for several families in need which is always a welcome gift.
