<p><b>January – Street Photography</b> Photography that features the human condition within public places not necessarily on a “street”. Assignment must include a person or persons. In color or black and white.</p>	<p><b>January – “The color...RED”:</b> The main subject must be red. The viewer’s eye should be drawn to the red immediately. Be creative, think outside the box! No B&amp;W for obvious reasons, no sepia or monotone!</p>
<p><b>March – Texas Landscape in B&amp;W</b> May be panorama, intimate or any scale in between. The location should be the title (but make it brief!)</p>	<p><b>March – Waterscape</b> An image that includes water in a natural setting. Water should be the dominant element in the picture. Streams, waterfalls, lakes, ponds, are all fair game. Color or monochrome.</p>
<p><b>May – Action Shots of People</b> We are talking about people who are moving be it sports, exercise, work, play, dance, etc. Could be riding a bicycle but not a car or motorcycle. Could be rowing a boat but not riding in a motor boat. MUST DEMONSTRATE ACTION! Color or monochrome.</p>	<p><b>May – Photo of a Pet Animal</b> Doesn’t have to be your own. Color or monochrome.</p>
<p><b>July – Urban Night Photography</b> Subjects might be reflections, neon signs, streaking lights, skylines, monuments, fireworks, individual buildings, street lights, carnivals, museums, overlooks and views, bridges, fountains. <b>Color only.</b></p>	<p><b>July – Circle</b> Used to create a compelling image. May be one circle or many.</p>
<p><b>September – Rust</b> Make an interesting composition that features something rusty. It could be a fence, sign, roof, wall, shed, utensils, tools, vehicle, etc. Must show the detail, texture and beauty in the color of rust. <b>Color only</b></p>	<p><b>September – Hands</b></p>
<p><b>November – A Garden/Cultivated Flower</b> We have often focused on Texas wild flowers but this time it should be roses, orchids, lilies, exotics, etc. Find it in your own garden, a friend’s garden, a public garden or even buy one. Center of interest should be on one flower though could include others in a properly treated background. <b>Color only.</b></p>	<p><b>November – Stripes</b></p>
