

Exterior Holiday Decorations Policy

Effective May 1, 2018, the following Exterior Holiday Decorations Policy will go into effect:

Valentine's Day, St. Patrick's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, Fourth of July: Decorations can be put out up to one week before the observed holiday and must be removed the day following the holiday.

Halloween and Thanksgiving: Decorations can be put up two weeks before the holiday and must be removed within one week following the holiday.

Christmas, Hanukkah, Kwanzaa, New Year's: Lights and decorations can be put up no earlier than the Friday after Thanksgiving and must be removed by January 31.

Birthday celebrations: Decorations visible to the community can be put up the day of and must be removed within five days.

Small exterior festive white lights: May stay up for extended periods in rear yard only.

For any holiday not specifically addressed, please contact management.

Exceptions must be approved by the Board in advance.
