Houraisen established in 1864 has some of the softest water in Japan, and produces a very soft & pretty style of sake.		
NV Amanoto Junmai Ginjo 300ml	Akita	58
The smallest producer of the 47 breweries in Akita, they make only Junmai sake and do not filter any of their sakes. Akita region typically shows a fresh steamed rice character.		
NV Tengumai Yamahai Jikomi Junmai 300ml	Ishikawa	44
Established in 1823 in beautiful pastoral lands surrounded by mountains that provide the pure local water. Ishikawa prefecture is known for it's complex sake style. This is made in a traditional method known as 'Yamahai' which produces a complex umamai character to the sake.		
Kenbishi 'Kuromatsu' – Honjozo 180ml	Hyogo	29
The oldest sake brand dating back to 1505. Notes of cream brulee, cocoa, maple syrup and nougat, medium dry and viscous texture. Recommended warm. (Please allow 6 mins for preparation)		

- White Oak Akashi Eigashima Blended Shuzo ABV 40%** 15
Vanilla, caramel, honey & spice. Flavours of apricot, dry fruits, herbs & spice
A blended whisky from the White Oak distillery, originally a sake distillery. Made in the scotch tradition. Lightly peated malt, vatted in mostly ex bourbon cask and balanced by White Oaks unique variety of barrels.
- Hakushu Distillers 'Reserve Single Malt' ABV 43.5%** 16
Grassy & fruity aromas combine with malty-vanilla notes. Medium weighted with biscuity vanilla flavours balanced with gentle malt spice.
A single malt whisky set amongst the high elevation of the Japanese Alps. Imported malt, local regional ultra-pure water & low pressure distilling produce this delicious whisky.
- Nikka 'All Malt' ABV 40%** 18
A plush palate of dark chocolate cake, candied orange peel and sweet spice, enlivened by a mild peppery backnote
A fascinating whisky made with Yoichi, Miyagikyo and some 'grain' whisky that isn't really grain – it's malt whisky made in a Coffey still at Miyagikyo! This is really a vatted malt, or 'blended malt whisky', as we're supposed to call it these days.
- Suginishiki Shochu - 13YO Oak Cask ABV 43%** 19
The taste created inside the barrel is a mysterious thing that cannot be easily replicated by artificial aromas or other means. Must be tried to experience!
Ordinarily Japan's traditional rice spirit, shochu, is not barrel aged, but when Sugii-san started making it in 2000 he became fascinated with the way barrel ageing of another distilled drink, whisky, results in rich aromas.
- Shinshu Mars 'Iwai Tradition' ABV 40%** 19
Aromas of ginger cookie, rice pudding & vanilla. Palate displays notes of biscuit, cinnamon & vanilla finishing with crisp smoke characters.
Produced at high altitude on Kuyshu Island, the Iwai Tradition is a blended whisky of malt and grain and is distilled only during the island's harsh winters.
- Kirin 'Oak Master' ABV 43%** 19
Well balanced with notes of earthy oak, rich malt. Clean & crisp on the finish
A no age statement blended whisky rarely available outside Japan. Matured in oak and internally scorched by flame, flavouring the whisky with fragrant char like character.
- Hibiki 'Japanese Harmony Master's Select' ABV 43%** 20
Resinous, woody aromatics followed by cocoa, dates and oak shavings. Medium weight of dried fruits, hazelnut and wood spice.
A blended whisky of ten or more malt & grain whiskies, aged in five different casks from the Yamazaki, Hakushu and Chita Distilleries.

Yamazaki 'Distillers Reserve' ABV 43%

On the palate you'll find coffee and chocolate with a hint of smoke.

A fantastic Japanese malt and one of the best currently produced bearing the Takesuru name. Crafted using malt matured in sherry casks which gives the whisky a rich spiced nose of sherry soaked plums and raisins.

Huge dollops of caramel, honey and vanilla are immediate and pronounced. Biscuits, baking notes are supported by black tea and earthy hints.

Fuji Gotemba, located in the city of Gotemba at the base of Mount Fuji, Chief Blender Jota Tanaka has favoured the medium and heavier grains along, of course with malts, to create the Fuji Sanroku 50. It is the first permanently available entry-level Japanese blended whisky which is not chill filtered.

(S) Sustainable - otherwise known as Lutte Raisonnee in French (the reasoned struggle) is a farming practice whereby farmers first and foremost will use all methods possible to save crops before using chemical treatments, most often excellent producers who farm in marginal areas that have high disease pressure.

(O) Organic - is the growing of grapes without the use of synthetic chemical sprays.

(B) Biodynamic - builds on organic viticulture, it is philosophy based, combining the maintenance of sustainable soil fertility and the recognition of the link between plant growth and the rhythms of the cosmos. Biodynamics relies on a series of preparations based in mineral, plant and animal substances rather than the traditional potentially toxic chemicals and sprays.

(N) Natural - refers to a wine making philosophy that builds on organic or biodynamic farming practices. Wines are made without additions of any kind (other than small amounts of SO₂ in some cases) and yeasts are wild rather than commercially made. In most cases the wine makers will endeavour to use grapes grown in an organic/biodynamic method
