





In order to expand Youth and Family Ministry at First Lutheran we are proud to introduce **EPIC Mentors!** Mentors are a great way to bridge the gap between youth and adults. The overall goal is to assist youth in their faith formation and help them feel apart of the congregation prior, during and after completion of Confirmation. EPIC Mentors will be able to share their talents provided by God with the youth through multiple options including but not limited to:

- One year commitment
- Chaperone one EPIC every other month
- Attend at least one youth "event" per season (sports arts, etc.)
- Communicate with youth (from above) via letter or E-mail
- Meet with EPIC Mentor team once per year

Optional one time commitments:

- Present to youth at an EPIC (via. Information, how to, field trips etc.)
- Chaperone a youth group event
- Donate snacks and drinks for EPIC and/or Youth Trips
