Robert Birr gave the Zoning Administrators report with 9 permits being issued. 1 to resolve an issue with an already existing rustic cabin, 1 for a deck and 1 for a porch expansion the remainder for pole building structures.

John Miedema brought up the possibility of discussing secondary dwellings on parcels. Discussion was brief and tabled hoping to finalize the changes to the Temporary event ordinance.
