## Currently Reads:

Section 3. INTERNATIONAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS: The Officers named in ARTICLE IV, Section 1, all past and current International Commanders will have a vote in all matters before the Board. The Board of Directors is the governing body of the International Association Legions of Honor when the membership is not in session and will meet at the Arlington Wreath Laying, the Annual Convention, upon the call of the International Commander when necessary and prudent and upon the request of five (5) members of the Board of Directors. The Board will meet for the purpose of, but not limited to, recommending policy to the Intemational Commander and will approve a Budget for the ensuing year at the Arlington Meeting. Only members of the Board will be admitted to any meeting of the Board, except that the Board may invite others to attend. Members will be notified of all called Board meetings by the International Adjutant's Office at least ten (10) days prior to a virtual (i.e., Zoom meeting) meeting and thirty (30) days prior to an in-person meeting.
