BLOOD DRIVE

January 27, 2022, 8 am - 1 pm

The rules for donating have changed recently. We can now accept people who otherwise might not been able to donate in the past. This includes many who have cancer. Previously, there was a five-year deferral after the last treatment. Certain skin cancers made for a permanent deferral. Now, most cancer survivors are eligible to donate immediately or one year after their last treatment.

Potential donors in our group understand that you can donate if you are healthy, on blood pressure medications, have diabetes, and/or take aspirin as a daily regimen. Even having a recent tattoo or traveling out of the country to a high malaria risk area defers them for only one year.

Donors can be as young as 16 with written permission and 17 years of age with verbal permission. There is no upper age limit.

The ALYX system collects only red blood cells. This donation can be given once every 112 days. However, this counts as two donations. Ask for information on your next donation.

PLEASE NOTE: Our regular donors are scheduled for their donation on January 27th from 8 am to 1 pm. Please remember to bring a photo identification.
