Deletion of old milling rule 11-12d.

Reasoning:

New milling rule voted in at year-end meeting, this one should have been deleted in conjunction with that one but was missed.

Current Rule to remove:

11-12d All District Heat races will use a half course mill, with all boat launches and re-launches initially going around turn one.

Proposal #2 - Submitted by

Modification of District rules regarding full course mill

Reasoning:

Now that the new milling rule/process has been used in practice we believe it needs a bit of a tweak. One of the reasons it was updated to indicate that a half course mill could be used until all boats were launched was for the safety of those boats still needing to be launched and the pitmen launching them at some of our race sites. Updating the rule to have the half course until all boats are launched will make it consistent everywhere.

Current Rule:

During a heat, boats will launch and go around turn one and [may cut the course until the last boat is launch](#), the CD will then announce that a full course mill shall commence. There shall be no cutting of the course unless the CD during a heat indicates the course may be cut for course interruption.

Proposed Rule:

During a heat, boats will launch and go around turn one and [then follow a half course mill until the last boat is launched](#), the CD will then announce that a full course mill shall commence. There shall be no cutting of the course unless the CD during a heat indicates the course may be cut for course interruption.
