

The **AARP Foundation** is once again offering **Free Tax Preparation** for low to moderate income tax payers, especially those 60 and older. The volunteers are trained to assist you in e-filing your returns, however, the Volunteers Protection act requires that Volunteers stay within the scope of the program. We cannot prepare rental / business income, HSA / COD returns.

Are you wondering what all the fuss is about regarding the installation of "smart" power meters in our homes? Have questions? Well, here's your chance to find the answers. Our chapter and the Town of Ocean City are sponsoring a town meeting/forum on the topic. The event will be held on Wednesday, March 12, at 11 a.m., at the OC Senior Center at 41st street (same place as our membership meetings). Speaker Jim Smith, DP&L's Public Affairs Manager, will speak on the benefits of smart meters. Speaker Jonathan Libber, President of Maryland Smart Meter Awareness, will speak against smart meters.



February 13, 2014 – Our speakers were Nancy Bradford (Assistant VP, Branch Manager, Bank of Ocean City), Raymond Robinson (Assistant VP/Loan Officer, Security Officer, Taylor Bank), and CPL R. Dale Trotter (Community Policing Division, Worcester County Sheriff's Office), who discussed the topic of "Financial Abuse of the Elderly". It was surprising to hear that most abuse of this kind is committed by family members. The speakers reminded us that we should not give out personal information over the phone, that we should be very careful when using the Internet, that offers received over the phone or in the mail that seem "too good to be true" are indeed that, so ignore them.
