

Though the wicked sprout like weeds and evildoers flourish, they will be destroyed forever.




But you, O LORD, are from everlasting to everlasting and will be exalted forever.

PASSING THE PEACE



The body of Christ was broken for you. The blood of Christ was shed for you.






THE LORD'S PRAYER




