November Lunch Summary

The November, 2011 SAABE luncheon had a great presentation on "Preventive Roof Maintenance" provided by Jon Pett and Lucas Villareal from Cram Roofing. Below are some important items for your preventive roof maintenance "to do" list:

- Inspect twice a year and after every major storm
- Inspect underside of deck prior to rooftop
- Inspect perimeter flashings and unit flashings first
- Inspect membrane after flashings inspection
- Clean all drains, gutters, and downspouts of debris
- Clean all miscellaneous debris off of roof
- Repair all small holes and open laps as soon as found with similar materials (i.e., asphalt asphalt)
- Provide redundancy in flashings
- Install or re-install coatings to surfaces for reflectivity
- Inspect copings and walls
- Install extra drains to make sure roofs are free of water within 48 hours
