

## Town of Nassau Schools Before Centralization

<u>District Number</u>	<u>Name</u>	<u>Comments</u>
1	Chatham Street School in Village of Nassau	Now firehouse in Village of Nassau.
2	Slab City School House	On Hoags Corners and Nassau Millers Corners Road; burned in 1930s.
3	Clark's Chapel	On Clark's Chapel Road near Schodack town line ; site used before 1854; present building dates from early 1900s; moved to nearby private property.
4	Central Nassau	On Central Nassau Road near cemetery; site used before 1854; present building built in early 1900s.
5	Lord's Hill	On Route 20 east of Lyons Lake Road; torn down for road construction.
6	Brick School House	On Jefferson Hill Road; now private residence.
7	Bliss School House	Was across road from present restored home; very early school location.
8	East Nassau	On Route 66; torn down for highway construction.

<b><u>District Number</u></b>	<b><u>Name</u></b>	<b><u>Comments</u></b>
9	Hoags Corners	In Hoags Corners; early school built 1830; replaced by school built in 1868; abandoned and fell down.
10	North Nassau	On North Nassau Road next to the Second Baptist Church of Nassau; moved to nearby private residence.
11	Alps	On Pikes Pond Road. Now a private residence.
12	Millers Corners	North of Millers Corners on Burden Lake Road; no longer standing.
13	Tsatsawassa	On Tsatsawassa Lake Road south of the lake; now a private residence.
14	Brainard	On Route 20 in Brainard; a private residence was built on the site.
15	Greenman Hill	Between Dunham Hollow and Hoags Corners south of Greenman Road; built in 1805; no longer standing.
16	Dunham Hollow	On Route 43 west of the West Stephentown Baptist Church; built in 1829; still standing.
