Dr. Rosalind Fuse-Hall

has nearly 25 years of experience in higher education, most of that time in senior management positions. In 2017, she became the Director of Legal and Governmental Affairs and Commission Support for the Southern Association of College & Schools, Commission on Colleges in Atlanta, GA. SACSCOC is the regional accrediting agency for the 11 states in the

southeastern United States. She served as president of Bennett College in Greensboro, North Carolina from 2013-2016, developing two new academic programs, stabilizing enrollment and increasing extramural funding to the college. Prior to her arrival at Bennett College, she served as the Chief of Staff for Florida A&M University (FAMU), working with the FAMU Board of Trustees, President James H. Ammons and a wonderful group of professionals known collectively as the Leadership Team. At FAMU, she also served as the Interim Executive Director of Title III programs, managing \$10 million dollars in special programs to enhance institutional strengths and student outcomes as well as secured an additional \$10 million dollar grant for academic success programming.

A North Carolina native, Ms. Fuse-Hall worked with Chancellor Ammons at North Carolina Central University, serving in a similar role. She worked on two special initiatives that brought nearly \$44 million to the University. One was the Biomanufacturing Research Institute and Technology Enterprise (BRITE) Center for Excellence. This research institute brought together the biotech industry, governmental officials, community colleges and a major research university to secure \$19.1 million in capital funds to build the institute and an additional \$7 million in annual operating funds from the state legislature. The second project resulted from a public-private partnership that built a 408-bed residence hall on the newly created West Campus of the University.

Ms. Fuse-Hall has worked for the University of North Carolina system, as the Corporate Secretary to the Board of Governors; the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, as Associate Dean in the College of Arts and Sciences; and at St. Lawrence University, as the Director of Minority Affairs. She is a graduate of UNC Chapel Hill and Rutgers School of Law. In 2016, the UNC Chapel Hill Board of Trustees and faculty bestowed upon Fuse-Hall the Distinguished Alumna Award. She began her professional career as a judicial law clerk with the Honorable William H. Walls, and then as a staff attorney in the Enforcement Division of the US Securities & Exchange Commission in the New York Regional Office. She has spoken to numerous groups on topics ranging from governance, academic advising, as well as women and leadership in higher education. She is a strong advocate for higher education and truly enjoys her work. She is married to Dr. Jarvis Hall, a political science professor at North Carolina Central University, and her proudest achievement to date is their daughter, Ifetoya, a 2018 graduate of New York University, receiving her Master's degree
