According to a press release, the camp will be held June 16–19 for children with [asthma](#) and [Camp Seven Seas](#) for children with [diabetes](#).

The day camp will be held at the [Temple Emmanu-El Community Center](#), 65th Avenue North and [Kings Highway](#) from 8:30 a.m. – 3 p.m.

The camps are for children, ages 7 – 11, who have [asthma](#) or [diabetes](#), require regular medication and are under a physician's care. T

The cost for the day camp is \$25, which includes meals and all field trips. Scholarships are available.

“The goal of the camp is to help children manage their [asthma](#) or [diabetes](#) successfully through education and proper use of their medication,” says [Mark Schecker, MD, allergist and medical director of the camp](#). “We also want the kids to enjoy camp activities such as field trips and other activities that they might shy away from because of possible [asthma](#) or [diabetes](#) problems.”

Each day will begin with medication and a short education session.

Camp activities, including arts and crafts, field trips, games and music fill the rest of the day.
