

GERHARD W. STING

1915-1994

Gerhard W. Sting, 79 of Sebawing, died Wednesday morning, Aug. 10, at Hills & Dale Hospital, Cass City, following a lengthy illness.

He was born at Black on March 22, 1915, the son of Theodore and Rose (Schweitzer) Sting.

He was married to Delores A. Gall in Immanuel Lutheran Church, Sebawing, on Nov. 1, 1944, and she survives him.

He served in the U.S. Army during World War II.

Mr. Sting had been a milk hauler for Michigan Producers Dairy in Sebawing for several years, and later was custodian of Immanuel Lutheran Church and School for 23 years, retiring in 1980. He was a member of Immanuel Church and Sebawing VFW Post 4115.

Surviving are his wife Delores of Sebawing, one son and daughter-in-law, Roger and Lynda Sting of Abbeville, CA, one daughter, Valerie Sting of Hallandale, FL; two sisters, Nora Schram of Detroit and Mrs. Arnold (Arlene) Becker of Unionville, one brother, Waldo Sting of Unionville, and several nieces and nephews.

One brother, Milton Sting, preceded him in death.

The funeral service took place Saturday morning, Aug. 13, in Immanuel Church, with Rev. Martin Hegericher officiating. Burial was in the church cemetery. Graveside committal services were held under auspices of VFW Post 4115, Sebawing.
