## 1908 - 1996

Marie Adlam, 88, lifelong resident of Unionville, died Monday afternoon, Aug. 12. She was born in Unionville May 12, 1908, the daughter of John P. and Mary (Horch) Krusa. On Sept. 6, 1926, she and Milton Adlam were united in marriage. He preceded her in death on May 21, 1970.
