
May is also the month we honor our fallen heroes on Memorial Day: "In memory of many, In honor of all. Thank you."

Viking Sisters



Viking Voyager or Whole Life

We have a popular life insurance policy for kids called the Viking Voyager. It is a term policy usually purchased for grandchildren with a one-time payment of \$500 for a \$25,000 policy. It is good until the child is 26 years old and can be converted to a \$75,000 life policy regardless of the health of the insured.


