Lala Drona (b. 1988)

is a Venezuelan-American painter and video artist, born in Denver, Colorado. After receiving a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Colorado, Lala Drona has since published and exhibited her work internationally. Most recently, her videos and paintings exploring digital spaces and the female gaze, were shown at the Cite des Arts de Paris. Her paintings, videos, and writing explore "transitions between the virtual and the real" and "women in the digital The totality of her artwork contributes to, and exists within a fictional universe and mythology established online and then recontextualized in the physical world through paint on canvas, performance, and sculpture. She is based in Paris, France.



2013 - 2015







Every Woman, 2016 Acrylic on canvas on mirror box 50cm x 70cm

The form is inspired by the shape of each of the artist's breasts





This series examines our treatment of bodies found in digital spaces. Could the treatment of online bodies influence the real-life treatment of physical bodies?







The video "The Like Me" delves into the isolating effects of social media and examines the normalised anxiety we experience daily.










"Escape" delves into the healing, feminine power of nature after experiencing the implicit violence of living in a patriarchal society.











The performance art video "Willing" examines desire, choice, and notions of consent. It delves into the complexities of sexuality in western society.










Experiment 8: Lala Feeds Muse to Drone, 2015 Short Film, 4m32s View <u>here</u>


