4. D.N.R. Creel Limit Rules Apply. Minimum length - 18 inches - all species
5. Maximum 9 (nine) - rod limit
6. Boats must leave from and return to Pentwater Harbor.
7. Set Lines - 6 AM – Honor System
8. Fish must be at scales by 12 Noon - Weigh-in at Pentwater Village Marina Gazebo
9. All Prize Levels by weight – in case of tie, 1<sup>st</sup> Fish weighed is winner
10. One prize per Kid
11. Open to PSA Member Boats. Charter boats may enter (if PSA Member) – but abide by listed rules.
12. Pre - Register your boat with a PSA Board Member with Number Attending
13. BOUNDARY WATERS: North end Consumers Project (N 43-54-45), 2 miles south of Little Sable Lighthouse (N 43-37-00) and Pentwater Lake to Longbridge Road.
