

## MONTHLY BENEFIT LEVELS OF KANSAS RETIREES

In the following pages you will find the Monthly Benefit Levels of Kansas Retirees by County. Listed below is the list of parameters for the remainder of the document.

1. This information is calculated on the benefits 'sent to' Kansas addresses. Approximately **85%** of the benefits are sent to Kansas addresses.
2. To be included in the report, the retiree had to be in active status (i.e., receiving a benefit) on 12/31/2017 and have a county recorded in their electronic data base. These statistics cannot be tied back to anything to the KPERS Annual Report or KPERS Valuation Report because it is a subgroup that isn't normally reported. (This report was prepared at the request of KCPR.)
3. The report reflects only KPERS State, KPERS School and KPERS Local Retirees. It does not include beneficiaries or KP&F and Judges.
4. The numbers do not account for benefit selections like a life certain period, joint and survivor option, or partial lump sum option. The largest effect that a benefit option could have would be a 50% partial lump sum option. For instance, a retiree could have a maximum benefit of \$2,000, but if they take a 50% partial lump sum option, they have a monthly benefit of only \$1,000. Any benefit selection other than the maximum lowers that monthly benefit. The data only reflects the actual monthly benefit that is being received.
5. In 6 of the counties (Highlighted in Yellow) the "Less than 5" category was changed to "Less than 10". Without this change there would have been anonymity issues in the 6 counties.
6. Further parameters can be found on the pages of the report itself.

The information **above** has been provided by KPERS and very slightly edited for this purpose by KCPR. The original parameters were addressed to the requester representing KCPR. None of the actual report has been edited.
