Elsie F. Dutcher, 91 of Saginaw, formerly of Bay Port, passed away Friday morning, April 21, at Martin Luther Saginaw Home following a brief illness.

Mrs. Dutcher was born Oct. 18, 1903 in Kilmareagh, the daughter of the late John and Suzanne (York) Tribelhorn.

She was united in marriage to Elvin Dutcher July 23, 1922 in Flint. He preceded her in death on Nov. 3, 1975.
