Fall Festival

REPERTOIRE: Students may perform 1, 2, or 3 selections.
Memorization of the selection(s) is optional. However, if the selection is not memorized, two ORIGINAL copies must be provided as Xerox copies are strictly forbidden according to copyright law.
Three movement Sonatas or Sonatinas are allowed but there will be a **10 minute time limit** for each student's total performance.
As stated above, **pieces from all periods and styles are encouraged and permissible at both Fall and Spring Festivals** (i.e. classical, jazz, popular, a student's own improvisation, or standard teaching pieces).
Duets are permitted but teacher must get prior approval from the festival chairman to guarantee any scheduling needs. If both students in the duet are to be judged, they must both list the duet on their entry form and both must pay the entry fee. Only one duet per student may be programmed.
No taped accompaniments will be allowed.

FORMAT: Students are scheduled in small groups to perform in a relaxed atmosphere for a judge.
Interested persons (teachers, parents, and family friends) will be allowed to attend as **space permits**. NO CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 5 WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PERFORMANCE ROOM.

REQUIREMENTS: Students of CMTA teachers must be TMTA-SA members (Exception: adult students and kindergarten students).
Non-member teachers may enter students in this event, but must comply with all specifics itemized in Rule #6 of "Rules Governing Student Affiliate Activities" found in this handbook.
TMTA state theory test is NOT required.

APPLICATION: Payment of entry fees and enrollment must be completed before the designated deadline. Use the CMTA online database to enroll students. Submit one check (to cover entry fees of all students) to festival chairman.

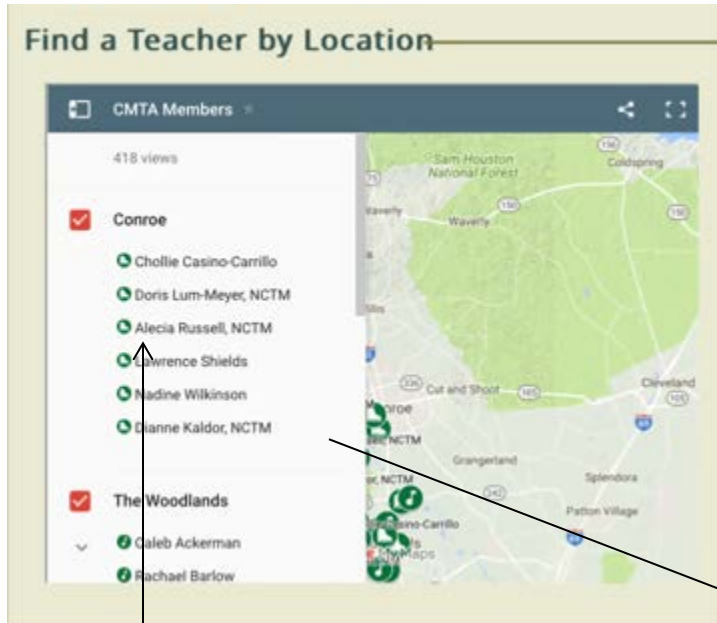

What happens if I enter the wrong password multiple times?
