This corporation shall have perpetual existence, unless it is dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE III PURPOSES AND POWERS

- (a) Purpose. - (b) Powers. In furtherance of the foregoing purposes, the corporation shall have and may exercise all of the rights, powers, and privileges now or hereafter conferred upon nonprofit corporations organized under the laws of Colorado. In addition, it may do everything necessary, suitable, or proper for the accomplishment of any of its corporate purposes.
