3. Food is to be exhibited on small plates and in plastic bags, not plastic wrap. Unless specified, only one-half loaf of bread is to be entered, unless entered in a “SPECIAL” class. No plates needed for any bread unless in a “SPECIAL”.
4. **No commercial mixes and or purchased pre-made products. Exhibit must be completely home made.**
