Did You Know?!

Both the hare and the egg have been symbols of fertility and renewal of life since the time of the ancient Greeks. Both symbols can be found depicted with Aphrodite, and also with the Germanic goddess Holda. In Christianity, eggs were symbol: of resurrection and made great gifts at Easter. The first recorded connection between rabbits and eggs appeared in a book by Georg Franck von Franckenau



in 1682, titled "De ovis paschalibus — von Oster-Eyern." He described how bunnies would hide eggs for children around Easter, and also warned that over-consumption of eggs may lead to stomach aches.

But the Easter Bunny wasn't always the main animal at Easter. Up until the early 1800s, bunnies competed with cuckoo birds, foxes, roosters and storks for the honor of hiding the eggs. Then, the hare prevailed. In the early 20th century, bakers all over Germany began to offer bunny pastries and, eventually, hollow Easter bunny chocolates (made by using a centrifugal technique copied from beekeepers) in their stores. Today, some German children still believe that, if they are good, the Osterhase will lay a nest of colored eggs. Then, these will be hidden throughout the house for the children and family members to find!
