Breaking Service Records

VVCC celebrated its 25th Anniversary throughout 2017 and continued to break records for neighbor services. About 300 volunteers provided services including transportation to medical, physical therapy, dialysis, and other important appointments, grocery shopping, home visits, patient scribe, business assistance, handy person help, respite, and pet assistance. Our volunteers:

- Provided 52,342 neighbor services
- Delivered 60,763 volunteer hours
- Provided 49,050 rides

Guardian Angel Emergency Alert Units

VVCC got its start in 1992, providing emergency alert units to older adults at risk for falling down. The program is a cornerstone of the organization, loaning 433 units to households throughout the Verde Valley in 2017. The units connect seniors to family, friends and emergency responders.

Named #1 in nation for volunteer transportation

With 25 years in the making, VVCC was the winner of the National Volunteer Transportation Center's 2016 Grand Star Award. The award, sponsored by Toyota, was announced in 2017 and included the grand prize of a Toyota Sienna Mobility Vehicle. VVCC competed with 147 other volunteer driver programs around the nation that provide transportation services to older adult passengers.
