



THE STAR-STRUCK, PARALYZED DISCIPLES

Readings from Luke 9:

²⁸Now about eight days after these sayings Jesus took with him Peter and John and James, and went up on the mountain to pray. ²⁹And while he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became dazzling white.

³⁷On the next day, when they had come down from the mountain, a great crowd met him. ⁴⁰I begged your disciples to cast it out, but they could not."

On Transfiguration of our Lord Sunday, we read these verses among the Gospel reading from Luke chapter 9. Luke, not only tells the story of Jesus' transfiguration, Luke tells an accompanying story of, let's just call them "the star-struck, paralyzed disciples." These disciples have witnessed a transformation of the physical Jesus. They have seen "persons who are no longer alive." All of this happened up the mountain. And now that the disciples have come down the mountain, they seem to have become paralyzed: not believing, not coming down the mountain and sharing the story of the holy power of God, not carrying out the mission to "spread the gospel." Thanks be to God that we are not like that.... 😊. What should our response be to Jesus' act of transfiguring himself and transforming our lives?

On March 2nd we begin the season of Lent with Ash Wednesday. Lent is a season of realizing our sin and our need for repentance. Martin Luther wrote: *This is the good and happy news, that Christ has paid for our sin, and through His suffering has redeemed us from eternal life.* Christ died for our sins! What is our response to His death for our life? Pretty simple: Tell the story! Tell the story of Jesus and his love. Tell the story of Jesus and his blood. Tell the story of how your life has been transformed. Tell the story. Tell the story. Don't be paralyzed disciples, knowing of the transformation which has happened in your life, in your heart, and in your soul. Don't be paralyzed and keep others from hearing the story. Come down the mountain and tell the story!

At Christmas, we sing, Go Tell it on the Mountain. We want to shout the birth of Christ from the mountain tops! Here on Transfiguration Sunday, we come down the mountain to go to the people to tell the story, His story, everywhere.

Each of us has been impacted by a transformation. We are all story tellers! Come and hear the story! Go and live the story! Go and tell the story!

APPROVED. The mats were ordered at a cost of \$1,767.00.
4. Cancellation of In-Person Service: Due to the threat of a winter storm, the Executive Committee presented the motion that was voted on during the Report of the Executive Committee portion of the meeting. Council members were again encouraged to contact the members on their Care lists to inform them of the change.

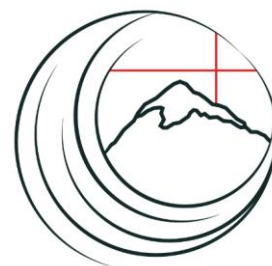

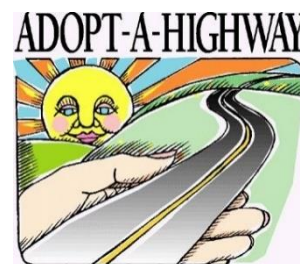


American Red Cross Blood Drive

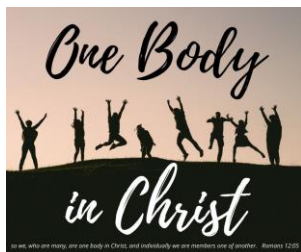

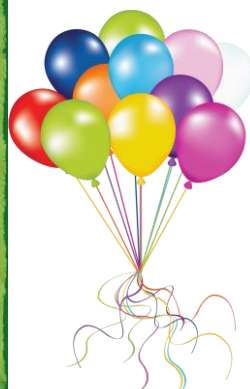
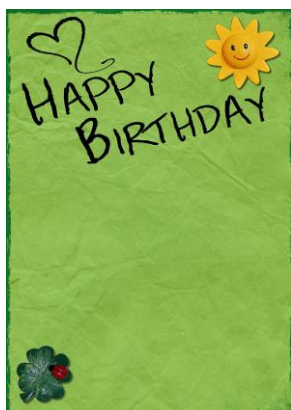
