Welcome to the 2017-2018 Hull Public School year!

If you are not already familiar with us, the Hull Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) is made up of parents and teachers working together to enhance our students' education. Together we support educational activities and initiatives including class field trips, in-school cultural programs, books, special guests and speakers, after-school and enrichment opportunities, and support for technology in the classroom.
