Tips of the Month

Tips came rolling in this month. Mary Edith M. and Sara P. gave tips on keeping your featherweight cases from smelling so bad. Mary Edith M. suggested using odor eaters, odor remover and perfume samples from magazines. Sara P. used a 150 watt light bulb inside of case. Do it outside for fire safety.

Natalie P. gave us tips for your machine. Us a 3m hook for scissors. Have a magnetic strip near your machine to place pins on. Use basting spray on the back of rulers to keep them from slipping. Did you know rubber bands work great to keep bobbins and spools of thread color types together.

Charlotte M. Gave a tip on how to keep you foot pedal from slipping just put rubber bands around it. Kim L. Told us she sprays best press on the back side of her fabric since the front already has some sizing on it. Karen D. told us when she gives a quilt away she gives them some matching fabric scraps for future repairs if needed. They can easily be slipped into a corner label if you use them.
