Nefertari, the Great Royal Wife of Ramesses II seems to have been particularly favoured by her husband, and not only had a temple dedicated to her at Abu Simbel, but also received one of the most beautiful tombs to have survived into the modern era.

Nefertari probably did not live even to the half way point in Ramesses’ reign, so what lay behind these special honours? Who were her children, and who took her place?

The SSAE was formed in 1992, primarily for people in the Chesterfield, Nottingham and Derby areas with an interest in Ancient Egyptian history and art.

The **SSAE local group** is self-funded and depends on door sales. The group is based in Chesterfield and organise a programme of 6 lectures a year and social/ fundraising events.
