QUAIL/PHEASANT RELEASE PROGRAM

Over the course of summer 2021 approximately 120 Quail and 65 pheasants were released on the club grounds.

We received the chicks in the mail when they were a day old and placed them in a surrogator box that provided food, water, and heat. When the birds matured 4 to 5 weeks later, they were released near the food plot of sorghum, sunflower, buckwheat, and corn.

A scouting camera has shown the birds on the club grounds weeks after the releases. If you spot any of the birds, we would be interested to hear your stories.
