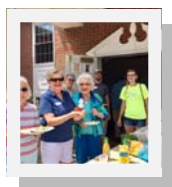
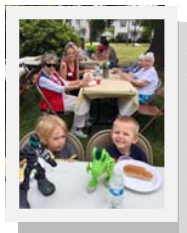

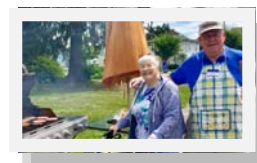

## WANTED: SANDWICH MAKERS!



For many youngsters in low income households their main meal of the day is the lunch they receive at school. Summer presents a problem for getting them a nutritious lunch. St. Susan's Center in Jamestown helps alleviate the problem by providing hundreds of sandwiches for youngsters during several weeks of the summer. Volunteers are needed to make sandwiches at St. Susan's five (5) evenings per week. The sandwiches are served the following day. Our church is committed to send a *minimum* of three (3) volunteers each Monday for eight (8) weeks. They will work from 4 PM to 8 PM beginning Monday, June 25. We have the minimum three signed up for each Monday. However, if we have a couple more volunteers each Monday the job will be done sooner and the volunteers will be able to return home earlier. As the saying goes "Many hands make light work!"

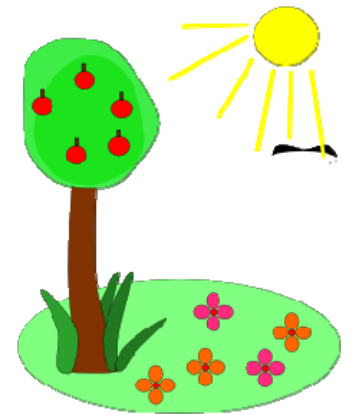

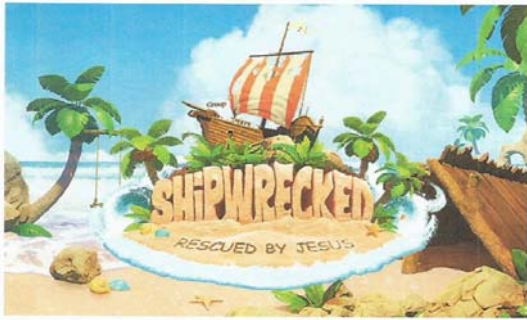

- \* Deacons report told of plans to clean the kitchens and their party/trip for the children.
- \* Clerk reported that our per capita for 2018 is \$31 a member.
- \* PNC presented Pastor Molly Golando to Session to be our next Pastor. Session gave their approval. She begins July 15.
- \* Outreach committee report shows plans for Neighborhood picnic, Fall training for program called "Stop the Bleeding" and helping at St. Susan's Center to make sandwiches this summer.
- \* Personnel is meeting with staff for their bi-annual review.
- \* Need for a maintenance form was discussed.
- \* Safety review was done. Fire/evacuation drill will be held in the fall.
- \* Plans for Baptisms during the summer was discussed.
- \* Our policy for sexual abuse prevention was discussed and plans made for additional training this fall.

### THE LOANS ARE PAID OFF!!!

With the sale of the manse and funds put into our reserve account during this 3 year period when we were without a full time pastor the Session has given the building fund the \$90,500 needed to completely pay off our loans for the addition to the church that made our building handicap accessible.

Over these past 10 years everyone has done a wonder job helping to raise the funds needed to make our monthly payments. Without the sale of the manse we would have been looking at another five years of fund raisers and pledges to finish paying off these loans.

Thank you to everyone who has stepped up to help. We can now look to the future and use our resources to meet the needs of our community outreach and mission projects.
