- 1. The tournament is USBC certified open to all Adirondack USBC adult women and multi-membership current adult women cardholders.
- 2. There will be a 4 woman team, doubles and singles with three games each, total pins scratch of nine games to decide all events scratch, total pins handicap of nine games to decide all events handicap.
- 3. You may bowl up to three times in each event, but no more than 3 same players on any one team, one same doubles partner, or single event. Bowlers cannot cash more than once in each event if bowling with same partner(s). Subs and sanctioned mixed league adult women are eligible. The scores used for all events, whether scratch or handicap will be the first ones bowled. One entrant cannot win both all events handicap and all events scratch.
- 4. Entering averages will be accepted in the following sanctioned adult bowling order:
 a. Highest previous winter average 2022-23 of at least 12 games or more; b. If (a) doesn't apply, highest 2023 summer average of at least 12 games. c. If (a or b) doesn't apply, highest current average of at least 12 games at time of entry;
 d. If no average, then bowler will bowl scratch; e.15 pin rule is waived.
- 5. Entries **close one hour** before squad begins. Tournament is handicapped at 100% of 230 and will be based on paid entries per event plus ADK USBC donation. All events will be divided in the same manner as other events, but scratch method applied instead of handicap for the scratch all events.
- 6. Entry fee will be \$22.00 per woman for team, \$22.00 per woman for doubles, \$22 per woman for singles, and \$4.00 per woman all events. This consists of team, doubles and singles (Bowling fee \$10.50 Expenses \$1.50 -Prize fund \$10.00). Checks or money orders are accepted and should be made payable to Adirondack USBC. THE ADIRONDACK USBC WILL BE CONTRIBUTING \$500 TOWARDS PRIZE FUND FOR THIS TOURNAMENT (used to supplement all prize money including AE handicap and AE scratch and add to payout spaces)
- 7. After entry receipt and acceptance by tournament director's scheduling of entrants, there are no refunds.
- 8. Subs are allowed, but please notify the tournament director at least one hour prior to start. If an emergency arises after start of the game, subs will be allowed: for team and doubles only. If no sub is available, only the frames actually bowled will count.
- 9. A sub will not be expected to reimburse the original bowler or to share any prize money the sub may win.
- 10. The lineup will remain exactly as it appears on the entry form.
- 11. Scheduling is done in order of receipt. No changes, except for emergency. Pairs of lanes will be assigned by the tournament director. If you wish to bowl with another group of entrants, state so on the entry form or assignments will be random.
- 12. Late bowlers will be allowed to bowl, but only the frames actually bowled will count. Zero score will be given for every frame missed.
- 13. Singles will be bowled immediately following doubles but if one bowler is late, the other may bowl singles first. If she has no sub or partner after that, she may bowl alone for all events total. This year you are allowed to bowl doubles without bowling singles and singles without bowling doubles.
- 14. If your team is alone on a pair of lanes, you must finish one frame before starting the next.
- 15. In team event, the captain only, checks in one hour prior to start. Singles/doubles check themselves in 30 minutes prior to start.
- 16. Any protest must be in writing to the tournament director before tournament prize payments are made. Scoring errors must be reported within 24 hours to the tournament director.
- 17. Entrants may re-bowl games/series only if scores are lost by automatic scoring device. The tournament director will investigate and authorize re-bowl.
- 18. Place ties will not be rolled off. Co-champions will be declared.
- 19. Prize money paid into each event will be returned to winners in that event only. Prizes will be paid for handicap scores in team, doubles and singles and handicap all events. All events scratch will be paid based on scratch scores. Donation money will be added to paid prize money and to add payout spaces.
- 20. The board of directors of the Adirondack USBC Inc. shall decide any question not covered by the tournament rules. The board shall have the power to hear and act on all protests concerning the tournament.
- 21. No food or beverages will be allowed in settee areas.
- 22. Automatic scoring will be used. Lanes will be oiled before each squad.

PRIZES WILL BE MAILED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE END OF THE TOURNAMENT, unless issues with software or other issues beyond our control. Adirondack USBC shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fee if entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through premature termination of the tournament which may be brought by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties, pandemics or other causes beyond the control of the Adirondack USBC.
