CHURCH COUNCIL HAPPENINGS

Motion from the Council meeting

November Council motions:

Support: Written report submitted. The Support Team recommends that we use Taylor Rentals (Neal Taylor, owner) to remove existing boxwoods and all roots from this removal and the prior shrubbery



removal in front of the church and Education Building, haul away all roots, boxwoods, and the concrete cylinders used for edging. The cost is estimated to be \$3,300 with \$2,000 to come from loan proceeds and \$1,300 from the landscaping donation. **PASSED** unanimously. The Support Team recommends that we use One 12 Landscaping to place cloth weed barrier and plants, and place pine straw in front of the church and Education Building. The cost is not to exceed \$8,700 with funds coming from the landscaping donation. The total for both recommendations is not to exceed \$12,000. **PASSED** unanimously.


