

ATTENTION RESIDENTS:

In an effort to streamline operations, enjoy cleaner streets and discourage dogs and other wildlife from scattering refuse throughout the community, I would like to take this opportunity to remind residents of key points in the Township's Landfill By-law.

1. The number of items (bags or tied bundles) that will be picked up per week/per household (family dwelling) shall not exceed 4 and no one item shall exceed 50 lbs. Plastic bags must not be larger than 36" x 24" and must be properly tied at the top.
2. All garbage bags set out for pick-up must be in a properly sealed plastic, wood or metal container, and must be sitting at your lot line in order to be picked up. Loose bags **WILL NOT** be picked up if not properly contained.
3. Residents must ensure that all garbage receptacles and bins are accessible and are kept clean of snow. The area in front of the bin must be shovelled out and be accessible to the worker or garbage will not be picked up.
4. Landfill Tipping fees apply to any items not considered household garbage. Household garbage is defined in Section 1a) of By-Law No. 1424 as:
"all rejected, abandoned or discarded household waste, either animal or vegetable, wearing apparel, waste paper, broken crockery; but shall not include weighty or bulky articles such as stoves, fencing, furnaces, bed springs, furniture, boxes and barrels or anything of a similar nature."
5. Each household is entitled to deposit a weekly allotment of four (4) bags or tied bundles at the landfill site at no cost.
6. All residents wishing to have garbage pickup **MUST** have proper containers in use by **Tuesday, December 1st, 2015** or the garbage will not be picked up.
