## Seeking M-PBEA Leadership Award Nominations for 2019

Perhaps you think of one amazing, outstanding leader, or perhaps you think of several. The Mountain-Plains Business Education Association has long had a legacy of active, involved members and leaders who ‘go the extra mile’ in the service of others. Why not show our appreciation for these leaders by nominating them for the **M-PBEA Leadership Award**?

**Nebraska** has many deserving members who have served at the state, regional and event at the national level who should be recognized for their leadership! **If you are a member of NBEA, you are automatically a member of the Mountain Plains Business Education Association (M-PBEA).** You can nominate someone for this award!

**The M-PBEA Leadership Award is the most prestigious award given to an M-PBEA member.** It was established to give recognition to those who have provided outstanding leadership to our association, regardless of whether or not they have held an office. The award has five categories in the judging criteria:

**Category 1:** Leadership in the **M-PBEA organization** (offices held, Board Member, convention committees, etc).

**Category 2:** Leadership in **other organizations in the M-PBEA region**, including the candidate's own state (offices held, committees served, awards received, etc).

**Category 3:** Leadership in **national and/or international associations** -- activities primarily separate from those in the M-PBEA region and organization. What is their leadership in NBEA, ARBE, PBL/FBLA, BPA, ACTE, ISBE)?

**Category 4:** Evidence of abilities in speaking/presenting, writing, and research.

**Category 5:** Evidence of abilities in teaching, counseling, and/or administration.

Nominees for the M-PBEA Leadership Award are asked to provide an electronic packet of supporting information addressing each of the five categories. Activities to be considered for the award should be limited to the last ten years.

**Submission deadline: March 1, 2019.**

The ACTE Member Awards recognize excellence and dedication within the field of career and technical education among ACTE members. Recipients of these awards are exceptional individuals who have contributed to the success of CTE through the quality of their work and their involvement in the CTE community.

Candidates begin the application process by nominating themselves (or being nominated by a peer) for their state award. Candidates must hold the appropriate position at the time of initial nomination. Applicants may full- or part-time educators. **Award winners will receive a one-year membership in ACTE/ACTEN dues.**

Candidates should submit their applications on the ACTE Awards Portal at [//acte.secure-platform.com/a/organizations/NE/home](http://acte.secure-platform.com/a/organizations/NE/home) by March 1, 2019.

Applicants will be applying for the **2021** ACTE Member awards because the national ACTE Awards naming convention is a year ahead. Candidates for the 2020 Member Awards will undergo their review in Nebraska in 2019, Region V and National review in 2020, and National winners will be announced at ACTE's CareerTech VISION 2021. State award recipients will have an opportunity to update their applications prior to their application being advanced to the regional level of competition.

Applicants will need to create an account and password before he/she starts the application. He/she will also want to remember his/her password so that he/she can save the application and go back to work on it again later. The deadline to apply for ACTEN awards is March 1, 2019. 
