# Quality of Life

---

- ▶ Housing (affordability and suitability) – 20
  - Altus AFB: partnered with Chamber of Commerce to drive construction of 112 affordable rental townhomes (\$900–1,200 month)
  - Los Angeles AFB: used MOU with city for priority rentals for military, reduced deposits, and release from lease if issued military orders





# Quality of Life

---

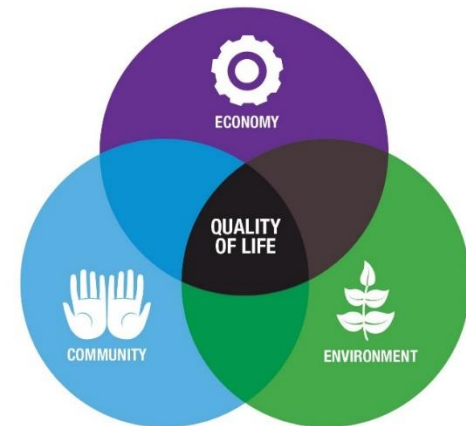
- ▶ Transportation capacity on roadways – 10
  - Luke AFB: Government association acquired grant funds, in cooperation with Luke, for growth management plan focused on transportation.
  - Joint Base San Antonio: used MOU with metropolitan transit to expand its “rideshare” program using transportation fringe benefits.



# Quality of Life

---

- ▶ Child Day Care / Medical Care – 5
- ▶ Charitable contributions (military & community) – 4
- ▶ Summer employment for teens – 2
- ▶ Divest/repurpose MWR @ Hurlburt
- ▶ Before and after school care



# Education / Training / Employment

- ▶ STEM (HSU Foundation) – 8
  - Multiple bases use federal grants to establish/maintain STARBASE program—STEM education opportunity.
  - Laughlin AFB: San Felipe Del Rio consolidated independent school district established STEM magnet elementary school on base.



# Education / Training / Employment

- ▶ Supporting trade skills at local schools – 5
  - Joint Base Elmendorf Richardson: used MOU to create “grow your own” apprentice/practicum program for vocational schools
  - Luke AFB: granted license to non-profit to operate Military and Veteran Success Center, offering holistic, case-managed transition services.

- ▶ Synch with tech colleges (OJT)
- ▶ Civil service hiring process
- ▶ Host more local area E&T conferences
- ▶ Federal support for civilian certifications
- ▶ Mentorship (consolidation & marketing)
- ▶ License reciprocity
- ▶ DOD SkillBridge Program



# Base Support

---

- ▶ Infrastructure grants/funding and contracted services – 6
  - Altus AFB: received \$400K Readiness and Environmental Protection Integration (REPI) grant to secure water rights and protect access points.
  - Ellsworth AFB: base and South Dakota Ellsworth Development Authority, secured \$12.6M DCIP grant for replacement fitness center.

# Base Support

---

- ▶ CATM expanded use agreements – 3
  - Dover AFB: leveraged MOU with local law enforcement to train on joint response, sharing their firing ranges.
  - Luke AFB: uses Maricopa County Sheriff's firing range through license agreement, sending service members, as needed, for specialized training.



# Base Support

- ▶ Cellphone coverage on base – 12
- ▶ Regional HAZMAT assistance – 2
- ▶ Integrated regional emergency dispatch
- ▶ Blanket IGSAs

# Other Successes

---

- ▶ Keesler partnered with Camp Shelby and public schools on hurricane evacuation, shelter-in-place, and facility weatherproofing
- ▶ Goodfellow shares vehicle mechanics/techs for maint. and repair with San Angelo School fleet in return for specified transportation
- ▶ Sheppard used Training Affiliation Agreement with MSU for school of nursing compliance requirements for undergrad nursing students

# Other Successes

---

- ▶ Seymour Johnson issued 20-year EUL with City of Goldsboro for development of multi-sports complex on 62 acres.
- ▶ WPAFB improved interoperability with land mobile radios (LMRs) using the Ohio Multi-Agency Radio Communication System
- ▶ Davis-Monthan leveraged University of Arizona expertise to improve health and living conditions of working dogs.
