Mayor Russell Wood, Jr. called to order the Village of Bloomingburg Regular Board of Trustees Meeting on August 8th, 2019 at 6:00pm in the Village of Bloomingburg Hall, Bloomingburg, N.Y.

The meeting was open with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Regular Meeting

Mayor Wood asked the Board if they had a chance to review the minutes from July.

Trustee Samuel Weingarten agreed he has as well as Trustee Aaron Rabiner.

Mayor Wood asks for a motion to approve the minutes from July. Aaron Rabiner makes the motion and is seconded by Samuel Weingarten.

Mayor Wood asks if the Board has had a chance to review the monthly bills from July. Mayor Wood asked for a motion to approve the bills, Samuel Weingarten makes the motion and is seconded by Aaron Rabiner.

Mayor Wood: I would like to start the meeting out by discussing the surveys for Winterton Road. Tom Depuy has finished them up and will have the maps to the Village in two weeks. From there will speak to anyone whose property lines might be effected but there really aren't many if any.

Mayor Wood: I have gone to the County again and have had a meeting with legislation on how important the sidewalks are on Winterton Road for safety. Also Office Chaboty accompanied me to this meeting and did a wonderful presentation on how the safety of the children is a huge concern as they have to walk to school every day. This is a concern especially since the school district will not provide busing for the development as they say its just under a mile from the school. We explained to the County that this will not cost them a penny. The County will not have to maintain them nor will they be responsible for them in any way. The legislators went into executive discussion and they will contact our Village Attorney Alex Smith on Monday.

Mayor Wood: The Village has received our DPW Truck. It is a 2018 Dodge Ram. It is the first official vehicle the Village has ever owned. We are going to have new Village logo placed on the side of it in the next few weeks.

Mayor Wood: I have a petition here from the Senior Building Godfrey Meadows. They are asking that we place more lighting on Godfrey Road on the Village end. It gets dark in the winter months and hard to see. We will have the pole numbers taken down and send over to Orange and Rockland for pricing on adding a few more lights for their safety and anyone else walking Godfrey Road.

Mayor Wood: Can I have a motion to get 2-3 lights on Winterton Road?

Aaron Rabiner: I will make the motion.

Samuel Weingarten: I will second the motion.

Mayor Wood: All in favor, Aye.

Mayor Wood: We picked up our new lawn mower on Monday. Blake submitted the paper work for CHIPS reimbursement for the roads. I do know there are still a few potholes where the roads weren't redone. We will get those filled.

Mayor Wood: Does anyone have any comments?

Mayor Wood: Can I have a motion to adjourn

Aaron Rabiner: I will make it.

Samuel Weingarten: I will second it.
