Elizabeth Louise (McCormick) Pomponio, 76, of Oak Forest, Ill., died Friday, February 7, 2003. Elizabeth "Betty" was born Oct. 26, 1926 in Huron County. Her parents were Patrick and Lena (Musselman) McCormick, of Pinnebog. Betty graduated from Pinnebog High School and attended Bay City Community College. In 1950, Betty married Gilbert Andrew Pomponio, of Shamokin, Pa. The Pomponios lived in Detroit for a few years, then moved to Blue Island, Ill., and later to Oak Forest.
