

## BALLOT ELECTION

## TELLER COMMITTEE

According to Robert's Rule of Order, the following procedures are required for voting.

## AzFRW Bylaws state that Officers are elected by ballot.

Roberts Rules Of Order states that "If the bylaws require the elections of officers to be by ballot and there is only one nominee for an office, the ballot must nevertheless be taken for that office, unless the bylaws provide for an exception in such a case."

AzFRW Bylaws state: "when there is only one nominee for an office the President may declare election by acclamation upon closing of nominations."

If there are nominations from the floor, and those nominees have followed protocol to be nominated, then there will be a ballot vote. The ballots will be prepared in advance of the election. Only those offices which have more than one nominee shall have names printed on the ballots in alphabetical order.

The Teller Chair, Sue Donahue, and her committee will distribute, collect and count the ballots as well as report the vote results and count to the President, who will announce the results and actual vote count to the body.
