

Purpose: To stop the illegal distribution and sale of Fentanyl within the United States and its territories.

The Federal Fentanyl Act of 2025

Section 1

The possession of Fentanyl with the intent to sell or distribute it in any form and in any amount without a legal prescription is prohibited by federal law. If found guilty in federal court of this violation, the only prescribed sentence is the death penalty.

Section 2

A person found guilty has the right to appeal to the closest geographical federal court within seven days. The federal court must add this case to its calendar within thirty days as it takes precedent over all other (dissimilar) cases. The appeals court may only affirm the original sentence or return it to the lower court for a new trial and then only based on errors in the original court's proceedings. One additional appeal to the U S Supreme Court is allowed. Should the Court agree to hear the case, that appeal must take priority over all other cases. No other appeals are provided for under this law.

Section 3

If the guilty verdict is upheld on appeal, the sentence must be conducted within thirty days after appeal's resolution.
