Where do we get the information?

• Pro Picks are the most popular picks taken from the top newsletters (Power Sweep, Gold Sheet, Playbook, etc) and also the most popular picks from the major nationwide handicapping contests.

• Public Picks are derived from the average betting percentages from the major sites that track them (Pregame, SportsInsights and ScoresandOdds.com).
 • Sharp \$ is where the bigger and wiser \$ is being placed (we get this info from sportsbook directors). The more \$ signs you see = the more \$ being wagered.
