

Agility Course Test (ACT)

Fox River Field Spaniel Club

Tests held at: WWCDTC, W1314 Cedar Drive, Ixonia, WI 53036

ACT 1 held on April 4, 2020; ACT 2 held on April 5, 2020

Entries Open March 2, 2020; Entries Close March 31, 2020. Priority to Field Spaniel entries. Day of event gate entries available if limit is not reached.

ACT 1 – each round limited to 20 runs. ACT 2 – each round limited to 30 runs.

Pre-entry: \$10 per run for Field Spaniels, \$15 other breeds.

Gate entry closes ½ hour before scheduled start of event/ if gate entry is available the fees are): \$15 per run for Field Spaniels, \$20 other breeds.

You may run your dog for fun in a non-judged run as space allows; dogs running for the ACT title(s) will be given priority.

This is gate entry only and accepted only as space allows. Release of liability form required: \$7 per run.

- **ACT 1: Round 1 and Round 2:** The ACT 1 test is designed for the beginning level dog to show sequencing and performance skills. Obstacles include 5' A-Frame, table, tunnel, bar jump, and may include panel jump and/or tire. An ACT 1 title requires two qualifying runs.
- **ACT 2: Round 1 and Round 2:** The ACT 2 test requires an increase in skill level shown by additional obstacles. Obstacles include 5' A-frame, table, tunnel, bar jump, teeter, 6 weaves, tire, and one spread jump (double, triple, or broad jump) and may also include dog walk and/or panel jump. An ACT 2 titles requires two qualifying runs.

Eligibility of Dogs: All dogs fifteen months of age or older that have not earned a title in any AKC Agility class may test. In order to acquire the title certificate and have the title added to the dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with AKC. Canine Partner applications may be accepted at the test by the judge/evaluator and submitted with the test results. Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may participate and their performance will be recorded by the AKC under a temporary recording number. The temporary recording number will be emailed to the owner and must be used when entering subsequent ACT events and when the owner registers/lists the dog. Note: Temporary recording numbers may only be used to enter ACT events. During the ACT events, dogs may jump at any height.

Instructions: Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events. In order to acquire the ACT 1 or ACT 2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program should be listed as All American Dog for dog breed and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC NO. box. Junior Handlers should enter their AKC Junior Handler Number on this form. If you have yet to obtain your Junior Handler number, you can do so by contacting the American Kennel Club at (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on this form, please list the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner under Handler.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge or ACT Evaluator, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events. In order to acquire the ACT 1 or ACT 2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered-listed with the American Kennel Club. AKC Canine Partners applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results. Dogs that are not AKC registered-listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time. AKC® NAME Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC NO. box. Junior Handlers should enter their AKC Junior Handler Number on this form. If you have yet to obtain your Junior Handler number, you can do so by contacting the American Kennel Club at (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on this form, please list the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner under Handler.
