Crazy Moose Fabrics 12" Block

What you will need:

Half Square Triangles

- (2) 5" squares of contrast color A
- (2) 5" of contrast color B

Center Four Patch

- (2) 3" squares of contrast color A
- (2) 3" squares of contrast color B



(4) 4.5" squares of contrast color C

Hall Square Triangles

Mark the light contrasting color fabric with 2 marks 1/4" to both sides of the diagonal.

Sew an A and a B square together on the 2 lines $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the diagonal. Cut on the diagonal. Then square down to 4.5"

Center four patch

Sew a contrast color A together with a contrast color b. Make two sets. Sew the sets together with matching colors on the diagonal. Square down to 4.5"

Putting together:

For rows 1 and 3, sew a half square triangle, a solid block and another half square triangle to make the row.

For row 2, sew a solid block, the four patch, and the other solid block to make the row.

Sew row 1 to row 2. Then sew row 3 to row 2. Block should measure 12.5" unfinished.
