Dear Grandma's Comfort Friends:

A young mother with three children under age 5 entered a local Christian shelter late one evening. As her laundry was being done, one of the volunteers (who also volunteers at *GC*) helped with the children. She told us this story:

<u>Volunteer</u>: What is that pretty bag you are carrying? <u>5-Year-Old Girl</u>: This is my "ditty" bag (a military expression), and it has a pencil, crayons, and paper. <u>Vol: Did you bring the bag with you?</u> (knowing full well that it was a *GC* comfort bag for children).

<u>Girl:</u> They gave it to me when I got here—and my little brother has one, too! (Smile)

Vol: What else does it have in it?

Girl: My brother got toys.

Vol: Does your bag have toys, too?

<u>Girl:</u> Yes. Do you want to see what I've colored? (And she handed over the little smiley-face memo pad. She had drawn on every page.)

Vol: Who is this you have drawn?

<u>Girl:</u> That's Jesus! <u>Vol:</u> And who is this? Girl: That's me!

Vol: Oh—well, you look alike!

Every page—a picture of Jesus. How I

long to have every page of my life be imprinted with the life of Jesus so that I "look alike" Him! Children teach us so much. We are grateful for all those who have told this young girl about Jesus!

[We have included a copy of the GC children's card that this young girl and boy would have received in their comfort "ditty" bags! The card highlights Jesus and children.]

And we are grateful for *GC* volunteers. One volunteer who heard this story was amazed—because she had wrapped the very comfort bags the little girl and her brother had received at the shelter. She was so uplifted! It is such an encouragement to see the work of your hands and heart find such a sweet home!
