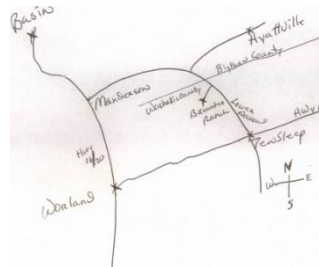
Awards for Men, Women, Junior and Sub Junior

A full slate of traditional Muzzle Loading events is planned. Primitive matches \$10.00, Paper Matches \$2.00. No optics except by range officers. Open front and rear sights only. NMLA rules for scoring. Only traditional Muzzle Loading hunting rifles using patched round balls.

Camp Rules: -Dogs are allowed but must be under adult control. No horses allowed. No vehicle parking allowed in the primitive camp area except to load and unload. Wood is available. We will have drinking water. However, plan on bringing extra water, sun screen, hats and other covering, as it can become quite dry and hot in August in the Big Horn Basin.
